



Access to the External Integrated Summative Assessment:

The purpose is of the EISA IS to promote consistency and credibility of the occupational qualifications issued. The criteria for this assessment are specified in the assessment specifications document and in the occupational qualifications document.

The external assessment will be conducted by means of written assessments at accredited assessment centres approved by Moonstone Information Refinery (AQP) over a period of not more than 3 hours.

In order to qualify for access to the external integrated summative assessment, learners must provide Statements of Results on all components of the qualification:

- **The knowledge modules**
- **The practical skills modules**
- **Workplace experience**
- **Foundational Learning Competence (two learning areas: Communication and Mathematical literacy)**

These four components will give you access to the assessment.
