### PROMOTION OF ACCESS TO INFORMATION ACT, 2000 (ACT NO. 2 OF 2000): EXEMPTION OF CERTAIN PRIVATE BODIES FROM COMPILING MANUAL

I, Jeffrey Thamsanqa Radebe, Minister of Justice and Constitutional Development, hereby publish under section 51(4) of the Promotion of Access to Information Act, 2000 (Act No. 2 of 2000), hereby exempt any private body, except any company which-

- (a) Is not a private company as defined in section 1 of the Companies Act, 2008 (Act No. 71 of 2008);  
and
- (b) Is a private company as defined in section 1 of the Companies Act, 2008 (Act No. 71 of 2008) which-
  - (i) Operates within any of the sectors mentioned in Column one of the Schedule to this Notice and has 50 or more employees in their employment; or
  - (ii) Has a total annual turnover that is equal to or more than the applicable amount mentioned in Column 2 of the Schedule to this Notice,

from compiling the manual contemplated in section 51(1) of the first mentioned Act for a period of 36 months from 1 January 2012 to 31 December 2015
