Sometimes a mail server on a subscriber side does not recognise the sender information as legitimate and is consequently blocking newsletters and some cases even our Moonstone newsletters as possible spam.

How to ensure that Moonstone newsletters are not tagged as spam by your mail server:

Unfortunately, the only way to address the problem is to have the following addresses "whitelisted" on your side:

Contact your IT support staff or Internet Service Provider and request that they "whitelist" the above addresses on the mail server(s).
