We only collect the minimum amount of information that is relevant to the purpose. ### How can you access your personal information?

If you would like to make a request to see what personal information of yours we might hold, or object to the processing of your personal information, you may make a request from our organisation website or contact us as per the details above.

Where it may have been necessary to get your consent to use your personal information, at any moment, you have the right to withdraw that consent. If you withdraw your consent, we will cease using your personal information without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before your withdrawal.
